In continuation of this Ministry's Letter of Intent of even number dated 6.2.2001 and with reference to your letter dated 16.3.2001 on the above mentioned subject, I am directed to convey the approval of the Central Govt. to the establishment of a new medical college in the name and style of "Era Lucknow Medical College" at Lucknow by Era Educational Trust, Lucknow with annual intake of 100 (hundred) students with prospective effect i.e. from the academic year 2000-2001 under Section 10(A) of IMC Act, 1956 as amended.

This permission of the Central Govt. for establishment of the college and admission of students is initially for a period of one year. It will be renewed on yearly basis on verification of achievement of annual target set out in the project report. This process of annual renewal of permission will continue till such time the establishment of medical college and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per norms of Medical Council of India. The students already admitted in the College on the strength of order dated 11.10.99 in WP No. 4387 of 1999 of Lucknow Bench of Allahabad High Court shall be adjusted against this permission and shall be treated as first batch of MBBS course in the college as per Supreme Court order dated 5.4.2000 in SLP No. 2517 of 1999 in the case of Union of India V/s Era Educational Trust & others. The College shall also apply to Medical Council of India for renewal of permission well before commencement of next academic session. While applying for such renewal, the achievement in terms of infrastructure, staff and equipment as spelt out in the time bound action plan and as required by Medical Council
