Lucknow: Internet is a powerful tool for accessing information, but it cannot replace the expertise of medical professionals. Relying solely on the internet for medical advice can be detrimental to patient care said Dr Mahalakshmi VN from Puducherry in her address at the 15th National Health Business Education Conference at Era's Lucknow Medical College and Hospital on Friday.
